

Sheena Jolley's Spirit of Freedom exhibition will feature animals of the Galapagos and West Indies

Animals of the Galapagos and West Indies will feature in Spirit Of Freedom – a photographic exhibition opening in Cork on Wednesday. It's the second solo show for Wicklow-born photographer Sheena Jolley. It follows her exhibition at Kinsale arts week last year.

Jolley's exhibition focuses on brief moments in the wild, as she aims to capture the spirit of her subjects in a subtle and insightful way. Her pictures are vividly colourful and have a quirky charm. "The pictures capture anything that moves," she said, "birds, seals, deer, red squirrels – but I'm still on the lookout for more."

Jolley, who is based in Kinsale, said her mixed media show would include framed prints and photographs, as well as limited-edition canvasses. The exhibits are for sale, with prices up to €295 for a framed A3 print on professional art paper.

Spirit of Freedom is at the Cork Vision Centre on North Main Street until June 28. Admission is free.
